The "art'17 Conference" will strive to achieve the above-mentioned goals by bringing together delegates, conservation scientists and curators, art historians, analytical scientists and architectural researchers.

These experts will meet in Turin, important business and cultural center located in northern Italy and first capital city of Italy. The technical and scientific programme will include both invited and short presentations and poster sessions that will highlight the application of NDT in a large number of important sectors.

Abstracts for posters and oral presentations are invited. Please follow some general information to submit an abstract to the ART'17 Conference.

Abstracts must be submitted within March 31st 2017 only online through the Conference website (<http://aipnd.it/art2017/scientific.php>). In fairness to all potential authors, LATE ABSTRACTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

To submit your abstract you have to create an account with a login and a password. The abstracts should be written according to the following guidelines:



- Abstracts must be submitted in English
- Title has to be written in bold capital letters
- 3 Keywords are requested
- indication of Authors' names (type the authors' names in sequence, separated by commas - each name must be followed by a superscript number as reference to each author's affiliation - indicate the corresponding author with an asterisk after the superscript number)
- indication of Authors' affiliations (list each author's affiliation in one line, preceded by the corresponding superscript number - add the correct and up-to-dated e-mail address only for the corresponding author)
- Text must be written in Word format, 20-30 lines, maximum of 300 words (spaces not included)
- Picture and tables are not allowed

The reception of any abstract will be confirmed to all corresponding authors by e-mail; after submission, abstracts will not be accessible for corrections. The authors may express their preference about the form of presentation, but the Scientific Committee will referee all submitted abstracts and reserves the right to decide the form of presentation (oral or poster).

Each poster or oral presentation can be presented during the Conference only if at least the corresponding author has registered and paid the registration fee. Each Author can present up to 2 papers. Only fully registered participants will have their abstracts published in the Conference Abstract book. Authors of accepted contributions will be invited to submit a paper for publication in a special issue of an International Journal.

NB: Abstracts should be a condensed version of the final presentation and include all significant findings. Write the text so that readers who are not specialists will be able to appreciate the purpose of the study and understand procedures and conclusions. The text, entirely written in English, must include short introduction and motivation of the study, including experimental procedures, main results and conclusions. It is not necessary to divide the text into sub-sections.

DATES and VENUE

The Conference will start on Wednesday November 22nd and will close on Friday November 24th, 2017 and it will be held in Turin (Italy) at Politecnico di Torino, Lingotto (www.polito.it).

The city of Turin has been the first capital city of Italy, it represents a great industrial center and a leading hub for art and culture: all these aspects enrich the city's cultural, architectonic and monumental background. The Regio Politecnico di Torino (Royal Turin Polytechnic) was founded as institution in 1906, but following the model of the most famous European Polytechnic Schools at the beginning of the 20th Century it moved in different directions: it began to contact both the European scientific world and the local and national industries; Aeronautics was born and in the new laboratories, from Chemistry to Architecture, young people built their professional future in a lively and creative atmosphere. The Regio Politecnico di Torino has become over the years an international school where traditions and future, past and modernity are closely interlinked.
